These are only approved by inclusion in course proposals or program proposals. Programs submitted with these on or embedded in MCMs will be returned to the submitting unit for clarification/rework.
5. Invented programs or those not approved through the University curricular process should not have a website or otherwise be advertised. Degrees/certificates/specializations/concentrations are listed in the Official List as to correct titles/names. Final Program notifications are issued and widely distributed, indicating approvals of new programs and changes to existing ones.
6. Catalog pages will be released to departments in mid-late February for edits to be included in the 18-19 General Catalog. Requests for confirmation of the appropriate personnel to edit department/college pages will be sent to UCC Reps in early February. The Catalog (CAT) workflows have been uploaded to the UCC Agenda FileShare under the '#CAT Workflows' folder (<https://eid.colostate.edu/filessharing/>).

<a href="#">Prohibit Use of Titles/Topics on Courses Numbered That Have Not Been Approved</a>	<p>In the scheduling process, departments have added topical titles to courses. This is not limited to group or independent studies. These unapproved titles/designations have been transcribed. These titles/labels have been used to designate sections, locations, etc. There has not been any review or approval through a curricular process to assure avoiding title overlap/repetition; appropriateness (connotation to the outside); use to distinguish sections, etc. There are options to this practice as 1) providing information on the 'course description screen' in the scheduling process (to direct students to the appropriate section, only the approved course title will be on the transcript-- not the added information) or 2) proposing experimental courses or subtopics to obtain an approved course title (will be transcribed).</p> <p>Therefore, effective Summer 2018, titles/topics will no longer be added to course titles in the scheduling process unless the course has been approved through the University curricular process.
