ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. The revised **Curricular Policies and Procedures Handbook** is now available on the Curriculum & Catalog website under Reference Docs & Other Resources: https://curriculum.colostate.edu/media/sites/130/2020/01/handbook-FINAL.pdf

The following are the main revisions to the Handbook:

- 1) A complete revision of the Education Abroad section.
- 2) Removing the '*Last revised*' date from the title page and adding it to each section heading so it's clear when each section was last revised.
- 3) Removing most of the paperwork in the Appendices, since paper forms are no longer used.
- 4) Misc. 'housekeeping' wording revisions to bring the handbook more up-to-date.
- 2. Pending policy update from CoSRGE: Allowing some 'double counting' of credits for joint and dual-degree programs.

3. Curriculum stats – FA19 and projections for SP20:

FALL 2019 – Curriculum proposals approved by UCC compared to previous four Fall terms (2015-2018):

- **33% increase** in COURSE proposals processed (535 compared to 402 4-year average)
- 73% increase in PROGRAM proposals processed (84 compared to 48.5 4-year average)

<u>2019-20 **PROGRAM** PROPOSALS</u> – We anticipate at least a 32% increase in the number of CIM proposals to be reviewed by UCC this year compared to the previous 4 years:

- Average # of CIM proposals processed annually (2015-16 to 2018-19): 167
- Projected 2019-20 CIM proposals: **220** (84 processed FA19; 136 pending in CIM queues)

2019-20 **COURSE** PROPOSALS – Harder to predict than program proposals because the SP21 deadline is 5/15/20, so likely will continue to receive proposals throughout the Spring term:

- Average # of CIM proposals processed annually (2015-16 to 2018-19): 723
- 535 processed FA19; about 300 pending in CIM queues
