ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. The first UCC meeting this fall is *anticipated* to be held the first week of classes, Friday, **8/28/20**.

3. UCC meeting minutes from 4/3 and 4/10 were approved on the 5/5 Faculty Council consent agenda. We anticipate that the 4/17, 4/24, 5/1, and 5/8 UCC minutes will be reviewed by the Executive Committee on behalf of FC on 5/12.
4. Be aware of the process within your college for the workflow of experimental courses. The Fall 2020 deadline for experimental courses to be approved out of your college is **7/17/20**. Consistent with the last four summers, experimental course proposals for Fall 2020 will be reviewed by the UCC Chair on behalf of UCC. All experimental courses approved over the summer will be listed on the first UCC Consent Agenda in the fall.
5. UCC approved a record number of course and program proposals during the 2019-20 academic year. Including proposals on this agenda, UCC will approve about **896** courses and **242** programs). Compared to previous 4-year averages (2015-16 through 2018-19), this is a **24%** increase in course proposals and a **45%** increase in program proposals.

7. The published 4/10/20 deadline for Experimental course for Summer 2020 will not be enforced.
