THTR-CDTZ-BA: Major in Theatre, Costume Design and Technology Concentration	<p>On 5/6/22, UCC approved the new Major in Theatre, Musical Theatre Concentration with language regarding an audition requirement before acceptance into the concentration. This language appears in the 'Additional Information' field in CIM. This allowed the creation of a 'Pre-Theatre' program code designed to cap the number of students enrolled in the Musical Theatre Concentration.</p> <p>The Major in Theatre is currently experiencing an enrollment bubble. To keep enrollment at a sustainable level, the department will start requiring auditions for <u>all</u> concentrations, not just Musical Theatre.</p> <p>Audition requirement language has been added to the 'Additional Information' fields in CIM for each of these concentrations.
